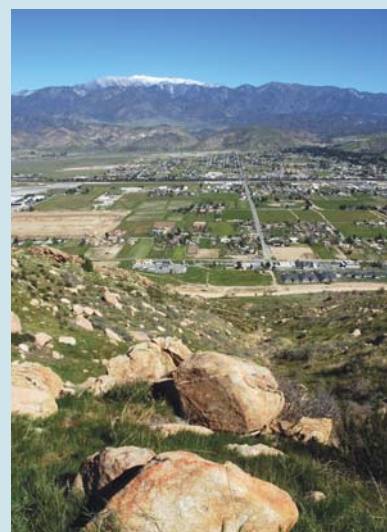
ADAPARATRANSITSERVICE

HOWTOUSETHEBUSSYSTEM

In commercial areas the bus will only stop at bus stops (identified by the Pass Transit Bus Stop signs). In residential areas the bus will stop at any corner on the route.

WHEN THE BUS APPROACHES:

1. Wave to the driver as the bus approaches. This will let the driver know that you want to board the bus.
2. Stand back from the curb so the driver is able to safely approach the stop.
3. Please have exact change for your fare or your bus pass ready when the bus arrives. Drivers do not carry change.
4. If you need a transfer, please ask the driver when you board the bus.

AS THE BUS APPROACHES YOUR DESTINATION:

1. Push the yellow strip or pull the chime cord to signal the driver you want to disembark at the next stop.
2. Please stay behind the yellow or white standee line until the bus stops and the doors open.
3. Please wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before standing up.
4. Please exit through the rear doors.
5. For your safety, please wait until the bus departs before crossing the street.

BUSSYSTEMPOLICIES

The following policies have been developed to help everyone to have a safe and pleasant trip. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Please do not speak to the Bus Driver while the bus is in motion. Only speak to him/her when the bus is at a complete stop.
- Please be patient when the driver is securing mobility devices.
- For your safety, please remain seated while bus is in motion.
- Please depart the bus using the rear door.
- Please leave the front seats open for senior citizens and persons with disabilities.
- Unsealed food or drink is not permitted on the bus.
- Music, smoking, and abusive language are not permitted on the bus.
- There is a limit of 3 carry-on packages per passenger.
- Strollers and carts must be folded before boarding the bus.
- The only animals allowed on the bus are service animals and small animals in secure pet carriers.
- If you lose an item on the bus, call our office at (951) 922-3243 or (951) 769-8532. If you find an item, please turn it in to the Bus Driver.
- Please hold infants and small children on your lap. Standing on seats or running about the bus is not permitted.
- Please use the trash receptacles provided and help us keep the buses and bus stops clean.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to persons who are intoxicated, abusive, or present a health and/or safety hazard to other passengers or the driver. Any action that interferes with the safe operation of the bus or that compromises the safety of the driver or any of the passengers is not permitted and is grounds for suspension of service.

TRANSFERS

1. When continuing on a one-way trip, a transfer is good for one (1) base fare of the route from which it is issued.
Example: The Pass Transit System fixed route base fare is \$.75. An adult transferring from a Pass Transit System fixed route to a RTA fixed route must pay an additional \$.50. The transfer from the Pass Transit System Route (\$.75) plus \$.50 equals \$1.25 (the RTA Adult fixed route fare).
2. Transfers are provided to allow customers to continue on their trip in the same direction. Transfers may not be used for stopovers or return trips.
3. Altered or mutilated transfers will not be accepted.
4. Transfers may only be used once. Also, a transfer will not be issued to a customer who boards a bus using a transfer.
5. Transfers are only good for a limited time. A transfer is good for two hours from the time the transfer is issued, or until the bus being transferred to arrives at the transfer point, whichever comes first.
6. Transfers are accepted by all Pass Transit System Routes and Dial-A-Rides and Riverside Transit Agency (RTA) Routes 31, 35 and 36.
7. Transfers are only accepted at the transfer points listed on the route map. Transfers to RTA routes are accepted at the K-Mart stop on Highland Springs Boulevard.

8. Transfers are only accepted at designated transfer points.

Transfers between Route 5 and Route 6 are only accepted at:

- Rite Aid Pharmacy on Sunset at Ramsey
- The Gas Company on Ramsey at San Geronio
- The Banning Post Office at Alessandro at Williams

Transfers between the Route 5 and Route 1 are only accepted at:

- Rite Aid Pharmacy on Sunset at Ramsey
- The Gas Company on Ramsey at San Geronio

Transfers between the Route 6 and Route 1 are only accepted at:

- Rite Aid Pharmacy on Sunset at Ramsey
- The Gas Company on Ramsey at San Geronio

Transfers between Routes 1, 2, 3, and 4 are only accepted at:

- Beaumont City Hall
- Wells Fargo Bank (Beaumont)
- Hospital

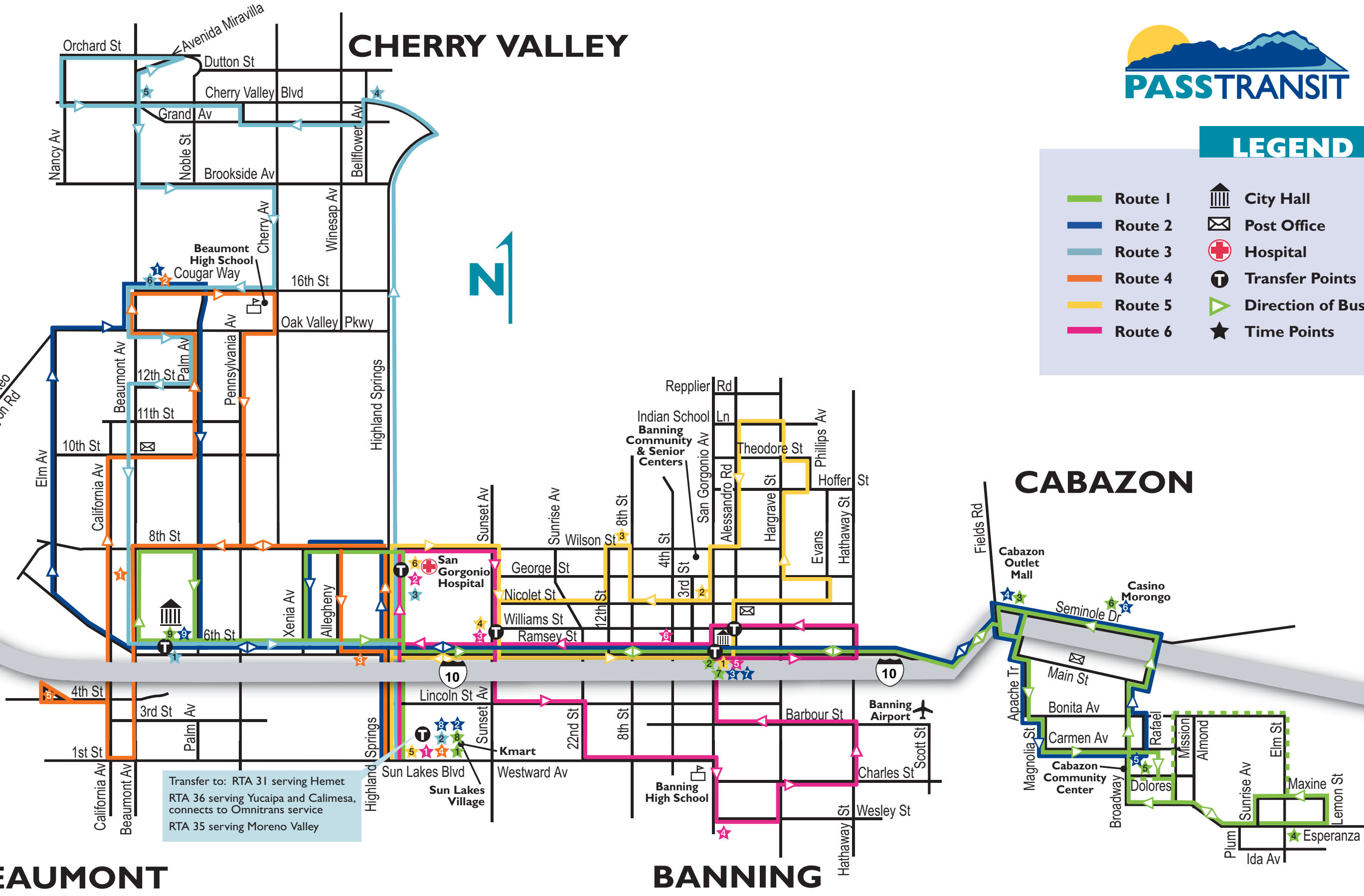
